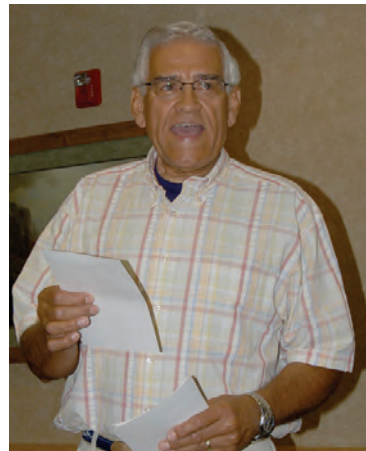

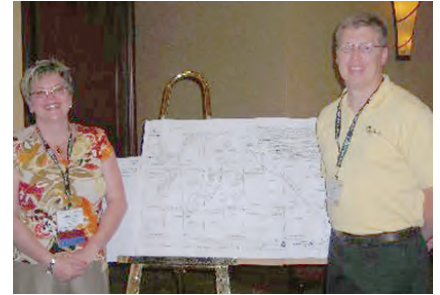
## So Much Good News, So Little Space

## Detroit International River Crossing Budget Controversy Continues...

Democratic and Republican legislators continued to face-off over how much further the state can go with the Detroit River International Crossing project, meaning no agreement has yet been reached on the overall 2008-09 Department of Transportation budget.

Rep. Lee Gonzalez (D-Flint) recessed the conference committee on HB 5808 after tempers began to get strained over the ongoing controversy.

Mr. Gonzalez had proposed language to allow completion of the DRIC study and require legislative approval before construction could begin. Republicans objected, saying that could allow for engineering studies, right of way acquisition and other pre-construction elements. No vote was taken on that language.

A proposal they then offered allowed completion of the study and nothing else without legislative approval failed on a 3-3 vote.

Rep. Matt Gillard (D-Alpena) offered a proposal that would have called for further legislative oversight of the Gateway project at the Ambassador Bridge, a project that has been underway for several years. The proposal clearly drew GOP ire and in the end Mr. Gillard was the only legislator to vote for his language. It was then Mr. Gonzalez recessed the meeting to the call of the chair.

to grab a cup of hot chocolate and peruse the *Great Lakes State-ment*.

Last month, Chapter 7 held its annual Fall Education Seminar in Traverse City. This was an excellent event discussing many relevant Right of Way issues. In addition, David Burgoyne, SR/WA presented the 7-Hour USPAP update for appraisers.

Topics of discussion on Thursday, September 25th included two different perspectives on wind energy development, differences in real estate vs. business appraisal, *Freedom of Information*

processes, and mineral rights. Also, David Maturen, SR/WA provided an update on the Sate Board of Real Estate Appraisers and the Appraisal Foundation.

Friday morning featured issues in condemnation or litigation appraisals for partial acquisitions; The Michigan Supreme Court ruling in the Tomkins case, i.e., special effects of a taking vs. general effects of a the project; a discussion of the need for advance preparation and coordination of resources in LPA projects entailing eminent domain litigation and Kelly Ramirez and Teresa Vanis of MDOT provided a comprehensive discussion of the relocation process.

If you missed the Fall seminar, perhaps you plan to attend November 14th Meeting at Zehnders in Frankenmuth. (See the front cover for details.) Whether you were in attendance

at last month's seminar or not, you may still have questions or you may desire to follow-up on any of these, or other, subjects.
