This is the highest award given to instructors by the IRWA. Mr. Burgoyne is an AQB Certified USPAP Instructor, has testified in Federal and State Courts over 100 times, and has been deposed on several hundred occasions. Mr. Burgoyne has been an independent fee appraiser since 1985 and has been instructing appraisal courses for IRWA since 1990. He has taught appraisal and other courses for IRWA in 15 different U.S. states as well as in Saudi Arabia and the People's Republic of China. Mr. Burgoyne is AQB Certified USPAP Instructor #10082. In 2015, Mr. Burgoyne won the 2014 W. Howard Armstrong Instructor of the Year Award, the highest award given to instructors by the International Right of Way Association.

Cancellation Policy: All classes scheduled by IRWA are subject to cancellation. Tuition Refund Policy: Written notification of intent to cancel registration must be received via email by both the Course Coordinator and IRWA Headquarters Education Staff (education@irwaonline.org) prior to the class start date in order to be eligible for a tuition refund. A full tuition refund will be issued if notice is received 15 days or more prior to the class start date; a 75% refund will be issued if notice is received less than 15 days prior to the class start date, and no refund will be issued for notice received on or after the class start date.
